- (2) (i) Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, an optometrist who has graduated on or after July 1, [1992] 2005 from an accredited school of optometry recognized by the Board is not subject to the requirements of paragraph (1) of this subsection.
- (ii) If an optometrist who has graduated on or after July 1, [1992] 2005 from an accredited school of optometry recognized by the Board is not certified under this section within 3 years of graduation, the optometrist shall successfully complete a therapeutic pharmaceutical agents course and successfully pass a pharmacology exam under paragraph (1) of this subsection before the Board may certify the optometrist.

- (a) In this section, "refer" means that a therapeutically certified optometrist:
- (1) Informs the patient that the patient should see an ophthalmologist and give the ophthalmologist an opportunity to physically examine the patient; and
