**Article — Financial Institutions**

**1-301.**

(b) (1) ~~“Fiduciary institution” means:~~

- (i) ~~A national banking association;~~
- (ii) ~~A State banking institution;~~
- (iii) ~~An other state bank that maintains a branch in this State;~~
- (iv) ~~A credit union that is organized under the laws of this State or of the United States;~~
- (v) ~~Any other organization that is organized under the banking laws of this State and subject to the supervision of the Commissioner; or~~
- (vi) ~~A savings and loan association that is organized under the laws of this State or of the United States.~~

(2) ~~“Fiduciary institution” does not include any person licensed by the Commissioner under Title 11 of this article.~~

**3-402.**

(a) A person may not commit or attempt to commit robbery.

(b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 15 years.

**3-403.**

(a) A person may not commit or attempt to commit robbery under § 3-402 of this subtitle:

(1) with a dangerous weapon; OR

(2) BY DISPLAYING A WRITTEN INSTRUMENT CLAIMING THAT THE PERSON HAS POSSESSION OF A DANGEROUS WEAPON.

(b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 20 years.
