- (A) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND DISSEMINATE TO EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL WITHIN THE COUNTY BOARD'S JURISDICTION A ONE-PAGE COMMUNITY RESOURCES LIST.
- (B) (1) THE COMMUNITY RESOURCES LIST SHALL MAY INCLUDE THE NAME AND CONTACT INFORMATION OF LOCAL AND STATEWIDE SOCIAL SERVICES, NONPROFIT LEGAL, AND NONPROFIT HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS THAT PROVIDE NONDISCRIMINATORY SERVICES TO CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN NEED OF ASSISTANCE.
 - (2) THE COMMUNITY RESOURCES LIST SHALL INCLUDE:
 - (I) COALITION OF FAMILIES FOR CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH;
 - (II) THE LOCAL CORE SERVICE ACENCY;
 - (III) PARENTS PLACE OF MARYLAND:
 - (IV) THE LOCAL PARTNERS FOR SUCCESS CENTER:
 - (V) LEGAL AID BUREAU;
 - (VI) MARYLAND VOLUNTEER LAWYER SERVICES;
 - (VII) MARYLAND DISABILITY LAW CENTER: AND

(VIII) THE NAME OF ANY-OTHER NONPROFIT SOCIAL SERVICES, LECAL, OR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER THAT PROVIDES THE APPROPRIATE AND NONDISCRIMINATORY SERVICES TO CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IN NEED OF ASSISTANCE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

7 - 305.

- (a) (1) In accordance with the rules and regulations of the county board, each principal of a public school may suspend for cause, for not more than 10 school days, any student in the school who is under the direction of the principal.
- (2) The student or [his] THE STUDENT'S parent or guardian promptly shall be given a conference with the principal and any other appropriate personnel during the suspension period.
- (3) THE STUDENT OR THE STUDENT'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN PROMPTLY SHALL BE GIVEN A COMMUNITY RESOURCES LIST PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH \S 7–310 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (b) At the request of a principal, a county superintendent may suspend a student for more than 10 school days or expel [him] THE STUDENT.
