holder of a wine festival license to deliver beer and wine 2 days prior to the effective date of the wine festival license and to accept returns 2 days after the expiration date of the wine festival license.

- (H) NOTWITHSTANDING § 11–512(C) OF THIS ARTICLE, A WINE FESTIVAL LICENSE ISSUED FOR USE IN ELECTION DISTRICT 11 OR 15 AUTHORIZES SUNDAY SALES:
 - (1) TO BEGIN AT 10 A.M.; AND
- (2) TO BE MADE WITHOUT A CONSUMER PLACING AN ORDER FOR A MEAL SIMULTANEOUSLY OR BEFORE PLACING AN ORDER FOR AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE.
 - [(h)](I) The Board shall adopt regulations to implement this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2005.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 943 - Natural Resources - Wildlife - Hunting Restrictions.

This bill authorizes a person in Dorchester County to hunt deer on certain Sundays on private land with a bow and arrow during October and November. It also prohibits a person, while hunting any bird or mammal, from shooting or discharging any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards of a church.

House Bill 1388, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 943.

AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources - Wildlife - Hunting Restrictions

FOR the purpose of authorizing a person in Dorchester County to hunt deer on <u>certain</u> Sundays on private property with a bow and arrow during certain months; prohibiting a person, while hunting any bird or mammal, from shooting or
