- (2) one member of the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee, appointed by the President of the Senate:
- (3) one member of the House Health and Government Operations Committee, appointed by the Speaker of the House;
 - (4) (2) the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, or the Secretary's designee;
 - (5) (3) the Secretary of Disabilities, or the Secretary's designee; and
 - (6) (4) the following members, appointed by the Governor:
 - (i) two representatives of the Maryland Veterans Commission;
- (ii) one representative of the Department of Business and Economic Development;
- (iii) one representative of the Minority Business Enterprise Program;
 - (iv) one representative of the American Legion; and
 - (v) one representative of the Disabled American Veterans; and
 - (vi) four representatives of the general public.
 - (c) The Governor shall appoint the chair of the Task Force.
- (d) The Department of Legislative Services Board of Public Works shall provide staff for the Task Force.
 - (e) A member of the Task Force:
 - (1) may not receive compensation for serving on the Task Force; but
- (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
 - (f) The Task Force shall:
- (1) identify the number of disabled State veterans who would benefit from State-awarded contracts for newly established small businesses;
- (2) <u>study and evaluate the potential fiscal impact of reserving State awarded contracts to disabled State veterans establishing small businesses;</u>
- (3) identify appropriate percentage goals for the number of State awarded contracts set aside for disabled State veterans establishing small businesses;
- (4) (2) identify existing programs, services, laws, and regulations that best address the issue of assisting disabled veterans establishing small businesses; and
