 - (5) AN INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITY FOR THE MENTALLY RETARDED;
- (6) A FACILITY THAT PROVIDES TREATMENT OR OTHER SERVICES FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE MENTAL DISORDERS; OR
 - (7) AN ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM.
- (C) "HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED OR CERTIFIED UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE.
- (D) "NONPROFIT CLINIC" MEANS A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES PRIMARY OR SPECIALTY OUTPATIENT HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO INDIGENT AND UNINSURED INDIVIDUALS FOR FREE OR AT REDUCED GOST.
