

(d) Each person required to file a return under this section shall file returns for other periods and on other dates as the Comptroller specifies by regulation, including periods in which the person does not pay wages subject to withholding.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 2006.

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**CHAPTER 6**

**(Senate Bill 84)**

AN ACT concerning

**Correctional Services - State Use Industries - Employment Readiness and Transitional Services**

FOR the purpose of allowing up to a certain amount of money from the State Use Industries revolving fund to be used by the Division of Correction to establish and operate employment readiness training programs and transitional services to rehabilitate certain inmates; and generally relating to State Use Industries.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Correctional Services**

3-507.

(a) The Department shall include the budget for State Use Industries in the Department's budget.

(b) (1) State Use Industries may establish a revolving fund to contain an amount that the Treasurer approves.

(2) (i) For each of fiscal years 2006 through 2009, the first \$1,000,000 in the revolving fund in excess of the amount required to operate State Use Industries shall be transferred to a special fund to be used by the State Department of Education for the operation of educational programs in correctional institutions.

(ii) Money from the revolving fund shall supplement and may not supplant funding for the operation of educational programs in correctional institutions.
