RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Council of The Town of New Market, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11-E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 19 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, entitled, "Corporations - Municipal," subheading "Home Rule," "Annexation," to enlarge the corporate boundaries of The Town of New Market as identified in Article I, Section 23-4 (Corporate limits) of the Charter of the Town and the description thereof by courses and distances, as referenced in said Charter, by adding or annexing to the present Corporate boundaries, the property, comprising 58.713 acres, more or less, described by courses and distances in a recent survey performed by Harris, Smariga & Associates, Inc., dated October 16, 2003, which description is incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution by reference.
