Section 12(3)(G)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

SECTION 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (3) (G) Baltimore Center for Children. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$400,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors of the Baltimore Child Abuse Center, Inc. for the construction, renovation, and capital equipping of the new Baltimore Center for Children building [to include handicapped access, a sprinkler system, elevators, an HVAC system, and interior walls to provide separate rooms,] located [at 2315 St. Paul Street] AT 2300 NORTH CHARLES STREET in Baltimore CITY, subject to the requirement that the grantee grant and convey an historic easement to the Maryland Historical Trust. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 12(5) of this Act, the matching fund may include real property or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act (Baltimore City) 400,000

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

AN ACT concerning
Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 - Baltimore City - Baltimore Zoo Trams
