

Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$500,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors of [Dorchester General Hospital] SHORE HEALTH SYSTEM, INC. for the planning, design, renovation, repair, construction, and capital equipping of the critical care unit and chest pain program to be located at 300 Byrn Street in Cambridge (Dorchester County)..... 500,000

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 32

(House Bill 159)

AN ACT concerning

Business Entities - Recordation of Documents

FOR the purpose of ~~repealing~~ altering a requirement that the Department of Assessments and Taxation return certain documents filed for record by certain business entities; ~~repealing~~ altering a requirement that the Department issue a certification of registration for certain foreign entities; repealing a requirement that the Department record previously unrecorded documents without additional charge; requiring the Department to send an acknowledgment after recording certain documents and, ~~on request~~, to return certain documents if accompanied by on payment of a certain processing fee unless the filer declines the return; establishing a certain processing fee; and generally relating to the recordation of certain documents.
