If the Department finds that an application for registration meets the requirements of this title and all required fees have been paid, it shall:

- (1) Endorse on the application the date and time of its acceptance for record;
 - (2) Record promptly the document; AND
 - (3) [Issue a certificate of registration to do business in this State; and
- (4)] (I) [Return the certificate of registration] SEND AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT to the person who filed the application or his representative STATING THE DATE AND TIME THAT THE DOCUMENT WAS ACCEPTED FOR RECORD; AND
- (II) AT THE REQUEST OF UNLESS THE PERSON WHO FILED THE APPLICATION OR THE PERSON'S REPRESENTATIVE; AT THE TIME OF FILING, ACCOMPANIED BY DECLINES THE RETURN, RETURN THE DOCUMENT ON PAYMENT OF THE FEE PROVIDED IN § 1–203(B)(10) OF THIS ARTICLE, RETURN THE DOCUMENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005.

CHAPTER 33

(House Bill 160)

AN ACT concerning

Insurance Producers - Continuing Education Requirements
