- (2) The best means to inform and educate prescribers if changes in prescription format or content are enacted;
- (3) The appropriate time frame and procedures for implementation of any changes enacted;
  - (4) Mechanisms for enforcement of any changes enacted;
- (5) The impact of any changes in the content or format of prescriptions on oral prescriptions;
- (6) Whether pharmacists should be prohibited by statute from dispensing illegible prescriptions; and
- (7) The use and cost of computerized physician order entry and the feasibility of eliminating handwritten prescriptions after a specified date.
- (c) (1) The workgroup shall report its recommendations [on or before November 1, 2004,] in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee.
- (2) THE WORKGROUP SHALL SUBMIT AN INTERIM REPORT ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY JULY 1, 2005, AND A FINAL REPORT ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 15, 2005.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October June 1, 2005.
