- D. Financial aspects, including the ability of the proposed user to construct, renovate, maintain, and operate a facility on the property;
- 2. Notice of the hearing is advertised in at least 1 newspaper having general circulation in the county at least once each week for 2 consecutive weeks, the last of which advertisement may not appear later than 1 week prior to the hearing; and
- 3. An appraisal of the property is made by the Commissioners to be included in the notice of public hearing; and
 - (iii) Shall adopt regulations for implementing this paragraph.

Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission 7-108.

The Commission may make and adopt and, from time to time, amend a plan which shall identify and designate sites, structures with their appurtenances and environmental settings, or districts having a historical, archeological, architectural or cultural value, provided that the criteria for the designation or identification is not inconsistent with the criteria applicable to the Maryland Historical Trust under [Article 83B, § 5-605 of the Annotated Code of Maryland] § 5-423 OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ARTICLE. In making or amending of the plan, the Commission may establish advisory committees to assist it in the performance of its duties. The plan shall constitute an amendment to the general plan for the Maryland-Washington Regional District except that the plan may include sites, structures with their appurtenances and environmental settings, or districts located in municipalities within Montgomery and Prince George's counties, not subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission, with the consent of the governing body of that municipality. Consent of the governing body shall constitute the agreement of the municipality to be bound by all rules and regulations governing such sites, structures with their appurtenances and environmental settings, or districts as may be enacted by the district council.
