(c) (3) If sidewalks or bicycle pathways within a designated neighborhood as defined in [Article 83B, §§ 4-202 and 4-203 of the Code] § 6-301 OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ARTICLE are constructed or reconstructed in response to a request from a local government and the adjacent roadway is not being concurrently constructed or reconstructed, the cost to construct or reconstruct the sidewalk or bicycle pathway may be funded entirely by the State.

(4) (i) This paragraph does not apply to a priority funding area that is a designated neighborhood as defined in [Article 83B, §§ 4-202 and 4-203 of the Code] § 6-301 OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 4-201(p), (q), (r), (s), (t), and (u), respectively, of Article - Housing and Community Development of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter 26 (H.B. 11) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2005) be renumbered to be Section(s) 4-201(o), (p), (q), (r), (s), and (t), respectively.

## CHAPTER 45

### (House Bill 338)

AN ACT concerning

### St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission - Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers - Surety Bonds

FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement that certain specific language be included in certain surety bonds given by the Treasurer and any Deputy Treasurer of the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission to the State of Maryland, the Metropolitan Commission, and the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County; requiring that certain surety bonds given by the Treasurer and any Deputy Treasurer of the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission to the State of Maryland, the Metropolitan Commission, and the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County contain a certain provision in a form approved by the Maryland Insurance Administration and the County Attorney for St. Mary's County; and generally relating to surety bonds given by the Treasurer and any Deputy Treasurer of the
