

A. THE 7-DAY SPECIAL CLASS B (INN) LICENSE IS VOID; AND

B. THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL RETURN THE LICENSE TO THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.

(XII) THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO:

1. IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH; AND

2. ENSURE THAT THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE SPECIAL CLASS B (INN) LICENSE IS TO ALLOW THE HOLDER OF THE LICENSE TO OPERATE AN ESTABLISHMENT AS AN INN.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005.

**CHAPTER 47**

**(House Bill 377)**

AN ACT concerning

**Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class B-BB (Bed and Breakfast) License**

FOR the purpose of establishing a 7-day Class B-BB (bed and breakfast) on-sale beer, wine and liquor license in Harford County; providing the qualifications that must be met for the issuance or reissuance of a license under this Act; restricting the holder of a license under this Act to the sale of alcoholic beverages to certain on-premises consumption and to certain individuals who are guests of the establishment; authorizing the holder of a license under this Act to keep for sale and sell alcoholic beverages during certain catered events; providing for an annual fee for the license; providing that a license issued under this Act is void under certain circumstances; authorizing the Liquor Control Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to 7-day Class B-BB (bed and breakfast) on-sale beer, wine and liquor licenses in Harford County.
