date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Charles County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.

Charles County - Alcoholic Beverages - Exemption from Sunday Sales Prohibition

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

11-403.

- (a) (1) A retail dealer holding a Class B or C license may not sell any alcoholic beverage at a bar or counter on Sunday.
- (10) THE PROHIBITION SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY IN CHARLES COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
