

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

3-1302.

(a) (1) The president of the County Board is entitled to receive **[\$4,900]** \$5,600 annually as compensation and the other members are entitled to receive **[\$4,800]** \$5,500 each annually as compensation. This compensation is to be paid in 12 equal monthly installments.

(2) Each member of the Washington County Board of Education is entitled to health insurance and to other fringe benefits regularly provided to employees of the Board of Education.

(b) After submitting vouchers, members shall be reimbursed for travel and other expenses within the limit set by the Washington County Commissioners.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the president or members of the Washington County Board of Education in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the president and members of the Washington County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.

CHAPTER 79

(House Bill 918)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Local Board of Elections - Salaries

FOR the purpose of altering the compensation for substitute members of the Washington County local board of elections; altering the compensation for election judges in Washington County; providing that this Act does not apply to the compensation for substitute members of the Washington County local board of elections; and generally relating to the compensation of substitute members of the Washington County local board of elections and election judges in Washington County.
