**CHAPTER 84**

**(House Bill 1118)**

AN ACT concerning

**Prince George's County - Class B-MB/22 Alcoholic Beverages License**

**PG 350-05**

FOR the purpose of establishing a Class B-MB/22 license in a certain legislative district of Prince George's County; authorizing the Class B-MB/22 license to be issued only to certain persons; setting an annual fee; authorizing the holder of both a Class B-MB/22 license and a certain micro-brewery license to hold a certain additional license; specifying that a Class B-MB/22 license holder is entitled to sell liquor under certain conditions; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

6-201.

(r) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

(14) (I) THERE IS A CLASS B-MB/22 LICENSE, WHICH MAY BE ISSUED ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS 7 MICRO-BREWERY LICENSE IN THE 22ND LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT.

(II) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$990.
