- (2) One member from the Republican Party Central Committee of Washington County;
  - (3) One member from the Washington County Chamber of Commerce;
  - (4) One member from the Washington County Farm Bureau:

  - (6) One member from the Western Maryland Central Labor Council;
- (7) [One member from the Washington County Taxpayers Association; and
- (8) Two members] ONE MEMBER FROM THE CUMBERLAND VALLEY ASSOCIATED BUILDERS AND CONTRACTORS, INC.;
- (8) ONE MEMBER FROM THE JOINT VETERANS COUNCIL OF WASHINGTON COUNTY; AND
- (9) ONE MEMBER at large selected by the Executive Committee of the Washington County Council of PTA's. The president of the Council may be [one of these members] THE MEMBER SELECTED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.
