SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 19 - St. Mary's County

23-5.

By December 1, 2000, and by December 1 every fourth year thereafter, the Commission shall:

(1) Review the salaries set by law for:

(I) St. Mary's County officials; AND

(II) MEMBERS OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION;

(2) Review State and local laws and the procedures followed in St. Mary's County concerning the inclusion of benefits as part of the compensation of [the]:

(I) County Commissioners; AND

(II) MEMBERS OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION;

(3) Make recommendations to the County Commissioners concerning the compensation set by law for [county]:

(I) COUNTY officials; and

(II) MEMBERS OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION;

AND

(4) Make a special recommendation concerning the inclusion of benefits as part of the compensation of:

(I) County Commissioners; AND

(II) MEMBERS OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.
