CHAPTER 90

(House Bill 1317)

AN ACT concerning

Secretary of State - Division of State Documents - Special Fund

FOR the purpose of creating a special fund for subscription and other product revenues of the Division of State Documents; providing for the use of the fund; requiring that the monies in the fund be invested and its earnings accrue to the General Fund; designating money deposited in the fund as supplemental; prohibiting the unspent balance in the special fund from reverting to the General Fund of the State; and generally relating to revenue of the Division of State Documents.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

7-216.1.

- (A) THERE IS A SPECIAL FUND IN THE DIVISION OF STATE DOCUMENTS.
- (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PAY THE COSTS OF PUBLISHING AND DISTRIBUTING THE PRODUCTS OF THE DIVISION.
 - (C) THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE DIVISION SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.
- (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- (2) THE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- (E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF REVENUE RECEIVED BY THE DIVISION IN PAYMENT OF ITS PRODUCTS.
