SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the title designation "Title 5.5. Docking Masters" of Article - Business Occupations and Professions of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the repeal of Chapter 675 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1998, Section 3, as enacted by Chapter 48 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004, is hereby validated.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Drafter's Notes contained in this Act are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as part of this Act.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
