

(b) Each year the [Secretary] DIRECTOR shall report to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly on the information provided by the counties on the distribution of money provided under this subtitle, including an assessment of the extent to which the purposes of this subtitle are being achieved.

8-106.

(a) (1) The [Secretary] DIRECTOR may withhold money allocated for the next fiscal year under this subtitle from a county if the county does not comply with this subtitle.

(2) After notice and an opportunity for a hearing, failure of a county to comply with this subtitle may result in the forfeiture of the allocated money, in whole or in part.

(b) Money withheld under this section reverts to the General Fund.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on October 1, 2005, all the functions, powers, duties, assets, and liabilities of the Senator William H. Amoss Fire, Rescue, and Ambulance Fund within the Department of State Police shall be transferred to the Maryland Emergency Management Agency.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.

## CHAPTER 102

### (Senate Bill 14)

AN ACT concerning

#### **Civil Actions - Limitation of Actions - Land Surveyors**

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
