**CHAPTER 104**

**(Senate Bill 31)**

AN ACT concerning

**State Employees - Military Administrative Leave - Sunset Extension**

FOR the purpose of extending the termination date for the use of military administrative leave or certain paid leave for certain State employees who are on active military duty on a certain date or are activated for military duty on or after a certain date; and generally relating to military administrative leave for State employees.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

9-1107.

(a) This section applies to all employees, except temporary employees, of all units in the Executive, Judicial, and Legislative branches of State government, including any unit with an independent personnel system.
