- (2) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland, if:
- ${\rm (i)} \quad Blind\ Industries\ and\ Services\ of\ Maryland\ provides\ the\ supplies\ or\ services;\ and$
- (ii) [State Use Industries] MARYLAND CORRECTIONAL ENTERPRISES does not provide the supplies or services; or
 - (3) sheltered workshops if:
 - (i) a sheltered workshop provides the supplies or services;
- (ii) neither [State Use Industries] MARYLAND CORRECTIONAL ENTERPRISES nor Blind Industries and Services of Maryland provides the supplies or services; and
- (iii) the State or a State aided or controlled entity is not required by law to buy the supplies or services from any other unit of the State government.

- (a) A fiscal/compliance audit conducted by the Office of Legislative Audits shall include:
- $\qquad \qquad (1) \quad \text{an examination of financial transactions and records and internal controls;}$
 - (2) an evaluation of compliance with applicable laws and regulations;
 - (3) an audit of electronic data processing operations; and
- (4) an evaluation of compliance with applicable laws and regulations relating to the acquisition of goods and services from [State Use Industries] MARYLAND CORRECTIONAL ENTERPRISES.
