SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

15-103.

- (d) (6) (i) An inspector shall receive an annual salary [of \$35,000,] AS SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, be reimbursed for reasonable expenses, and receive mileage at the standard rate set by the County Commissioners.
- (ii) Mileage does not include travel to and from the inspector's home and office.
  - (7) An inspector shall:
- (i) Possess the power of a peace officer of this State with respect to the enforcement of the alcoholic beverages laws of Frederick County;
