- (ii) [22%] 25%.
- (2) From the [22%] 25% that the licensee deducts from the handle, $\frac{8\%}{9\%}$ of the handle shall be paid to the Commission, which shall send it to the Comptroller to be credited to the Fair Hill Improvement Fund established in § 5–908 of the Natural Resources Article.
- (b) Money that remains after deductions are made under subsection (a) of this section shall be returned as winnings to successful bettors.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
