Ira Tyler, to that city, and have made application to the Surgeon General for his removal.

I beg to recommend Mr. John A. Needles, of this city, for a certificate as Assistant Agent here, as he is very willing to serve, and will be of much use, both in visiting the Hospitals and aiding in collecting supplies for the delegation at the Front.

Mr. King has just returned for supplies, having visited five Regiments at the Front, in person, and distributed tobacco, paper, pipes, &c., &c. They were delighted to see him, and expressed a wish that you might visit them. If not detained here, I propose to return with him in a few days, to visit the Maryland men at the Front.
