Endorsed—"States that she was cast into prison by Mr. Duvall, August 22nd, 1862, for stating 'that Mr. Lincoln was the man that God ordained to free the Etheopian.' That she was taken out of prison the 3rd day of February, 1863, and ordered to leave the State of Maryland for 15 years, and that Duvall took from her, her house and property."
