Howard—states that she was sent into prison by Mr.
Duvall, August 2nd, 1863, for stating that Mr. Lincoln
was the man that God ordained to free the African. Last

and ordered to leave the state of Maryland for 15 years, and
that Duvall took from her, her bones and property.
