

School District, or for any particular School within the State, any grant or devise of lands and any donations or bequest of money or other personal property made to it for educational purposes; and shall pay over to the State Treasurer for safe-keeping and investment, all money and other personal property so received. The Treasurer shall, on warrant of the Comptroller, pay from time to time the income of such investment, to the School Authorities of the City, County or District for whose benefit the bequest or donation was made.

SEC. 4. The incidental expenses of the Board, and the expenses of the members thereof incurred in the discharge of their official duties, shall be included among the incidental expenses of the office of the State Superintendent.

SEC. 5. The Secretary of the State Superintendent shall act, when necessary, as Clerk of the Board.

CHAPTER III.—STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION.

HIS POWERS AND DUTIES.

SECTION 1. The office of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall be located in the City of Baltimore, and he is hereby authorized to appoint a Secretary, at an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars, payable monthly by the Treasurer on the warrant of the Comptroller and the certificate of the Superintendent.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the State Superintendent when acting as Clerk to the Board of Education, shall receive no additional compensation, except his travelling and personal expenses when thus employed.
