Maryland Agricultural College. 5 Professors, 60 Students. Property \$60,000. Annual State Donation \$6,000.

College of St. James. Not in session. Property \$50,000. No State Donation.

UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND.

THE COUNCIL OF THE UNIVERSITY.

All Degrees shall be conferred by the Council, upon recommendation by the Faculties of the Colleges and Schools of Medicine and of Law.

The Course of Study in each College,—Scientific and Classical,—must be approved by the *Council*.

Each College may select Specialties without authority from the *Council*, viz :

Military Science and Tactics.

Practical and Scientific Agriculture.

Civil Engineering.

Mechanical Arts.

The Course of Classics and Mathematics in every *High School* must be uniform and designed as preparatory to the State Colleges.

The Council of the University shall nominate to the Curators of the Peabody Institute the Graduates of the Colleges who merit Special Honor.

The Commencement of all the Colleges shall be on the Fourth Day of July, and in the Hall of the Peabody Institute, when the Provost of the University shall confer the Bachelor's and Master's Degrees.
