

Question. Did you see all the persons who were there, at Ady's Hotel, at that time?

Answer. Well, I saw quite a number.

Question. How many do you suppose were there on the porch or pavement in front of the porch, at the time you speak of?

Answer. There was not a great crowd; I can't say positively how many; about thirty (30) I suppose.

Question. Were there not some members of the Horse Guards there during that time?

Answer. There was not more than two (2) or three (3) members there.

Question. Where was the flag, at the time you came there?

Answer. It had just been raised.

Question. At what time did you say this company ceased to appear in uniform?

Answer. A few days before the flag was raised; this was on Monday, and the company ceased to appear in uniform the previous Thursday.

Question. What was their uniform?

Answer. Blue coat and grey pants.

Question. Had you any badge?

Answer. No; not to my knowledge.

Question. Was Mr. Grason with them up to the time they ceased to appear in uniform?

Answer. I saw very little of Mr. Grason with them; I don't know where he was at the time.

Question. Was the company moving together at the time they were out rendering service?

Answer. They were sent out to different points.

Question. What was your point?

Answer. I was out on picket duty a little while at Govans-town, and above Towsontown a little piece.

Question. Who was the lieutenant in immediate command, of the command which you were in?

Answer. I suppose Captain Ridgely was when I was below Towsontown, and Lieut. Merryman when I was above.

Question. Were you at the time of this flag raising in the crowd at Ady's Hotel?

Answer. Yes; I was near the porch of Ady's Hotel.

Question. Do you know how long after the hoisting of the flag, that you got there?

Answer. Not more than a few minutes.

Question. At the time, was there any flag over Ady's Hotel?

Answer. No; I did not see any.

Question. Did you see any during the week they were out rendering service?

Answer. I think, may be I did, the first part of the week before.
