

The bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 133 of Article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws relating to the marriage of minors,

Section 1st, after the words "Prince George's" add "Montgomery county;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Miller, of Washington, moved to strike out the enacting clause;

Which was decided in the negative.
