

The bill entitled, an Act to add to the Code of Public General Laws an article under the title of Militia, and to provide for the organization and discipline of the military forces of the State,

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.

Mr. Nairne submitted the following amendment:

Section 2, line 1, after 1st and 2d, insert 3, 9 and 10th, in lieu of 5, 6, 7 and 8th ;

Pending the consideration of which,

On motion of Mr. Buhrman,

The further consideration of the bill was postponed informally.

The bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Baltimore, Harford and Cecil Railroad Company,

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.

Mr. Silver submitted the following amendment:

In line 4, section 12 after the the word "Baltimore" insert "Central ;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Harris submitted the following amendment :

Amend section 23, by striking out all after the word "that" and insert "this road shall be commenced within two years from the passage of this Act, and five miles shall be completed in each year thereafter, commencing at the city of Baltimore, otherwise this Act shall be null and void."

Mr. Pilkington moved that the bill be re-committed to the committee on Corporations;

Which was decided in the negative.

The pending amendment was adopted.

The bill having been read a second time was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact sections 811 and 812 of the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland in relation to the pay of the police of Baltimore city;

Was read the third time and passed by yeas and nays as follow :
