Which was read and referred to the Harford county delegation.

Mr. Buhrman presented a petition from William Metzger and 124 other citizens of Frederick county, Maryland, against the passage of a law to tax the citizens of said county, to raise the 200,000 dollars given to the rebels by the citizens of Frederick ;

Which was read and referred to the Frederick county delegation.

Mr. Lee, of Baltimore, presented a petition of the wood corders of Baltimore city, praying for an increase in the price of cording wood in the city of Baltimore ;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Inspections.

Mr. Fawcett presented a petition from the citizens of Montgomery county, in favor of an increase of Sheriff's fees ;
