

On motion of Mr. Markey,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to change the name of Jacob Ijams Duvall, of Frederick county, to that of James Ijams Duvall.

On motion of Mr. Poteef,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations, to introduce a bill to incorporate the Warren Manufacturing company of Baltimore county.

On motion of Mr. Stewart,

Ordered, That one thousand additional copies of the report of the State Superintendant of Education, be printed for the use of this House.

On motion of Mr. Hazen,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary, to introduce a bill to repeal sections 44, 45, 46 and 47 of article 61, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to "mechanics liens" and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Mr. Poteet, from the committee on Claims, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Thomas S. Alexander and James Revell, for professional services rendered the State;

Which was read the first time.

Also, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act appropriating a sum of money to pay the claims of Henry H. Owings, for costs in the Orphans' Court of Baltimore and in the Court of Appeals, due him by the State in the case of Henry H. Owings vs. the State of Maryland;

Which was read the first time.

Also, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to make appropriation to pay the plaintiffs cost in the case of the State of Maryland against the President, Managers and company of the Washington and Baltimore Turnpike Road;

Which was read the first time.

Also, reported back the bill entitled, an Act appropriating a sum of money to pay the claims of James S. Crawford, George Jacobi, William Evans and Whitney, Cushing & Co.

With the following amendment:

Amend in section 1 line 7, by inserting after the word proclamation to Samuel M. Lawder or order, one hundred and seventy-one dollars and sixty-seven cents for fine and costs paid by said Samuel M. Lawder in case of the State of Mary-
