

Mr. Valliant, from a Select committee, reported favorably a Senate bill entitled, an Act to add the following section to the 20th, Article of Public Local Laws, entitled, "Talbot county," relating to fast driving through the streets of Easton;

Which was read the second time.

Also, reported favorably the bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 185 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to Talbot county, and to enact a new section in lieu thereof;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Lee, of Queen Anne's, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to authorise the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county, to levy a sum of money for the purpose of repairing and raising the causeway at Crumpton, on Chester River;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Williams, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to authorise James A. Bond, administrator of Thomas Hutchins, late Sheriff of Calvert county, to collect the fees due the said Hutchins;

Which was read the first time.

On motion of Mr. Norris,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Maryland Petroleum company.

Mr. Parker, from Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 413 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled, "hay and straw" and to re-enact the same with an amendment;

Which was read the first time.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following bills:

An Act to alter and change the name of Maria Behrens to that of Henrietta John;

Which was read and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

An Act for the relief of the Baltimore Humane Impartial Society and Aged Women's Home, enabling them to furnish a similar home for indigent and helpless old men, to be taken from all parts of the State and placed on an equal basis with those from the city of Baltimore;
