

General Laws, entitled, "Wild Fowl," relating to the catching and killing of partidges, woodcock and pheasants, and to re-enact the same with amendments ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Nairne, from a Select committee, reported favorably the bill entitled, an Act to authorize the Register of Wills of Worcester county, in the recess of the Orphans' Court of said county, to pass any account or claim against the estate of a deceased person for any amount not exceeding one hundred dollars, and in the return of any inventory of the personal estate of a deceased person to pass an order for a sale of the property contained therein ;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

Mr. Mules, from a Select committee, reported favorably the bill entitled, an Act authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, to build a new City Hall ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Hoffman, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to pay for visiting Almshouse of Baltimore county ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Williams, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Calvert Hotel and Improvement Company of Calvert county ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Mules, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to repeal sections 798, 799 and 802, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, and to re-enact the same with amendments thereto, relating to "abatement of nuisances ;"

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Anderson, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 74, of Article 35 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, "Elections ;"

Which was read the first time and by special order the second time.

Mr. Anderson moved that the rules be suspended to read the bill the third time ;

Which was decided in the negative.
