

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 146 of the 3d article of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the office of the Register of Wills for Baltimore county, and to re-enact the same with amendments;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Baltimore county delegation.

A bill entitled, an Act to pay William J. Jewell a sum of money for painting the President's Room;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Claims.

A bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to the Home of the Friendless;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

A bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 23 of article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the time of holding the terms of the Circuit Court for Harford county;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 52 of article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the time of holding the terms of the Circuit Court for Cecil county;

Which was read the first time and referred to committee on the Judiciary.

Mr. Robinson from a Select committee, reported favorably the bill entitled, an Act to add additional sections to the Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel county, to be entitled, Livery Stables;

Which was read the first time.

The bill entitled, an Act to encourage and facilitate emigration from Europe to the United States,

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.

On motion of Mr. Slothower,

The consideration of said bill was postponed informally.

The bill entitled, an Act appropriating a sum of money to compensate the bailiffs of Baltimore city, for the collection of taxes in arrears in said city due the State of Maryland for the years 1862, 1863 and 1864,

Was taken up for consideration on its second reading.
