

On motion of Mr. Wooden,

Leave was granted the committee on Public Buildings, to report a bill to appropriate a sum of money to pay the expense of fitting up, repainting and refurnishing the Court of Appeals rooms.

On motion of Mr. Lee, of Baltimore city,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Open Board of Stock Brokers of Baltimore city, and to regulate the sales of stock at said Board.

On motion of Mr. Pilkington,

Leave was granted the committee on Claims, to introduce a bill to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Charles A. S. Wolf, for repairing clocks, &c.

On motion of Mr. Smith of Allegany,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill to amend the Act of May 28th, 1853, chapter 337, to incorporate the Cumberland and Georgetown Transportation Company.

On motion of Mr. Ziegler,

Leave was granted the committee on Internal Improvements to report a bill to amend the charter of the Hagerstown and Leitersburg Turnpike Company.

On motion of Mr. Parker,

Leave was granted the Baltimore county delegation to report a bill entitled, County Treasurer and Clerk to Bounty Commissioners of Baltimore county.

Mr. Poteet, from the committee on Claims, reported favorably Senate bill entitled, an Act to pay Wm. J. Jewell a sum of money for painting the President's room;

Which was read the second time.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of Oliver Wood, William Welch and John Moorehead;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Jones, from the committee on Corporations, reported favorably the bills entitled, a supplement to the Act to incorporate the President and Directors of the Baltimore and Pikesville Railroad Company of Maryland, passed on the 26th of February, 1864.
