

On motion of Mr. Hynes,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill to amend the charter of the Concordia Association of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Buhrman,

Leave was granted the Frederick county delegation to report a bill to legalize the Acts of the Burgess and Commissioners of the corporation of Middletown, Frederick county, Maryland, in making a levy upon the citizens of the town to meet the requisition of Gen. Early, made in July, 1864.

On motion of Mr. Williams,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill regulating the pay of sheriffs for the board of prisoners.

Mr. Anderson, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported with amendments, Senate bill entitled, an Act to repeal Article 80, of the Code of Public General Laws, and the several sections thereof, and re-enacting the same with amendments ;

Which was read the second time.

Also, reported favorably, the Senate bills entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 52, of Article 8, of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the time of holding the terms of the Circuit Court for Cecil county ;

An Act to amend and re-enact section 23, of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the time of holding the terms of the Circuit Court for Harford county ;

Which were read the second time..

Also, reported favorably, the joint resolutions authorizing the Librarian to subscribe for 250 copies of Cohen & Lee's Digest of the Decisions of the Court of Appeals ;
