

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays with proposed amendments:"

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED:

Amend section 3, line 20, by inserting after the word "otherwise" the words "not exceeding one-half the amount of their cash capital paid in."

At the end of section 5, add "except for the services of laborers employed in and about their works."

Add to the end of section 9, "and the General Assembly reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this Act at pleasure;"
