

The Speaker appointed Messrs. Anderson, Smith, of Allegany county, and Slothower the committee.

On motion of Mr. Soper,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the McKendre Oil Company.

On motion of Mr. Darling,

Leave was granted the Select committee on the subject to report a bill enacting a law providing for the adoption of destitute children.

On motion of Mr. Soper,

Leave was granted the committee on Ways and Means to report a bill entitled, an Act to amend and re-enact section 2, of Article 33, of the Code of Public General Laws relating to the education of the deaf and dumb.

On motion of Mr. Willis,

Leave was granted the committee on Claims to introduce a bill to pay Josiah Jump certain fees due him as clerk of the court for Caroline county.

On motion of Mr. Pennington,

Leave was granted the Cecil county delegation to introduce a bill to regulate the issuing of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors within the town of Cecilton, in Cecil county.

On motion of Mr. Soper,

Leave was granted the committee on Ways and Means to report a bill entitled, an Act to indemnify the Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf and Dumb.

On motion of Mr. Pennington,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Colored Caulker's Trade Union Protective Association of Baltimore city.
