

The bill having been read the second time was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Willis, from the committee on Internal Improvements, reported favorably, a bill entitled, a supplement to an Act entitled, an Act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from Hagerstown, in Washington county, to the Pennsylvania line, passed December session, 1846, chapter 333 ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Soper, from the committee on Ways and Means, reported back to the House, with an amendment, the bill entitled, an Act to authorize the payment of bounties under the Act of 1864, chapter 15, to certain veterans from Allegany county, who re-enlisted into the service of the United States, in the months of December, 1863, and January and February 1864.

The bill being upon its second reading.

Mr. Soper submitted the following amendment :

Amend 4th line of the preamble after "1864," insert under the call of the President of the United States for five hundred thousand men made on the 17th day of October, 1863;

Which was decided in the affirmative.

Mr. Anderson submitted the following amendment:

Amend 1st section by inserting the words "and Washington county" after the word "county" in the 4th line;

Which was decided in the negative.

The bill having been read a second time was ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
