

An Act to add new sections to article 73 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the conduct of convicts in the Penitentiary;

An Act to amend article 73 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, "Penitentiary" by adding thereto sections providing for the care of insane convicts;

Which were read the first time.

Also, reported favorably the following Senate bills :

An Act to appropriate a sum of money to the House of the Friendless;

An Act to repeal and amend the 81st Article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to revenue and taxes;

Which were read the second time.

Mr. Buhrman, from a Select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to make valid the Acts of the Burgess and Commissioners of Middletown, Frederick county, Maryland, in levying a tax to pay the requisition made by General Early upon the citizens of said town in July, 1864, and to authorize the collection of the same ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. King, from a Select committee, reported favorably the Senate bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 3 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws, for Baltimore county, entitled, "Collections," and to re-enact the same with an amendment ;

Which was read the second time, by special order the third time, and passed by yeas and nays as follow :
