

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal the tenth section of Article eleven of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the oath of Attorneys or other practitioners of law, and to enact a substitute therefor;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the Judiciary

A bill entitled, an Act to provide for the completion of the restoration of the records and papers destroyed or injured by fire in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Baltimore county;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Baltimore county delegation.

Also, the following House bills:

A bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Baltimore and Hampden Passenger Railway Company;

A bill entitled, an Act to repeal an Act adding additional sections to the second Article of Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel county, regulating the running at large of stock in and about the city of Annapolis;

A bill entitled, an Act empowering Thomas Watts, John M. Wheeler and George Cullison, to sell the Cullison Meeting House property, in the fifth election district of Baltimore county, and use the proceeds for the erection of a church near Wheeler's School House;

A bill entitled, an Act to make valid the official acts of Justices of the Peace and Constables, who failed to qualify under the new constitution within the required time, and who have been re-appointed and since qualified according to law;

A bill entitled, an Act to change the name of Fannie Parker to that of Fannie Parker Roelkey;

A bill entitled, an Act to alter and change the name of Mary Hicks, of Caroline county, to that of Fennie Honora Eaton;

A bill entitled, an Act to alter and change the name of Zachariah Origen Simmons, of Frederick county, to that of John Simmons;

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays;"

A bill entitled, an Act to regulate and make uniform the fees of Justices of the Peace;
