On motion of Mr. Chew,

Leave was granted a Select committee of five, to introduce an Act providing for the appointment of Road Supervisors in the several counties.

The Speaker appointed Messrs. Chew, Rinehart and Pennington as the committee.

On motion of Mr. Slothower,

Leave was granted the committee on Colored Population to introduce a bill to regulate the hire of colored persons.

On motion of Mr. Kirk,

Leave was granted the committee on Claims to introduce a bill to compensate George M. Taylor for repairing the gas works in the Comptroller's office.

On motion of Mr. Chew,

Leave was granted a Select committee to introduce an Act providing for the greater security of prisoners;

The Speaker appointed Messrs. Chew, Stone and Darling, as the committee.

On motion of Mr. Dean,

Leave was granted the Allegany county delegation, to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 57 of Article 1st of the Code of Public Local Laws of Allegany county, relating to "deer," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion of Mr. Robinson,

Leave was granted the committee on Roads and Highways, to introduce a bill to allow the County Commissioners to regulate the price for labor upon the public roads.

On motion of Mr. Chew,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations, to in-
