Your committee cannot close this report without making their grateful acknowledgments for the kindness and courtesy extended to them by the officers and managers of the different institutions they visited in this examination, and expressing their high appreciation of the skill and fidelity of said officers and managers in the discharge of the duties and responsibilities they have assumed.

Resolved, That the President and Directors of the Maryland Insane Asylum, be and they are hereby requested to put into occupation the nearly completed portion of said Asylum Building.
