Mr. Valliant, from the committee on the Judiciary, presented a minority report on a bill entitled, an Act to add two sections to Article 93 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, "Testamentary Law," to be numbered 330 and 331, relating to the duties of the Registers of Wills and the several Orphan's Courts of this State;
